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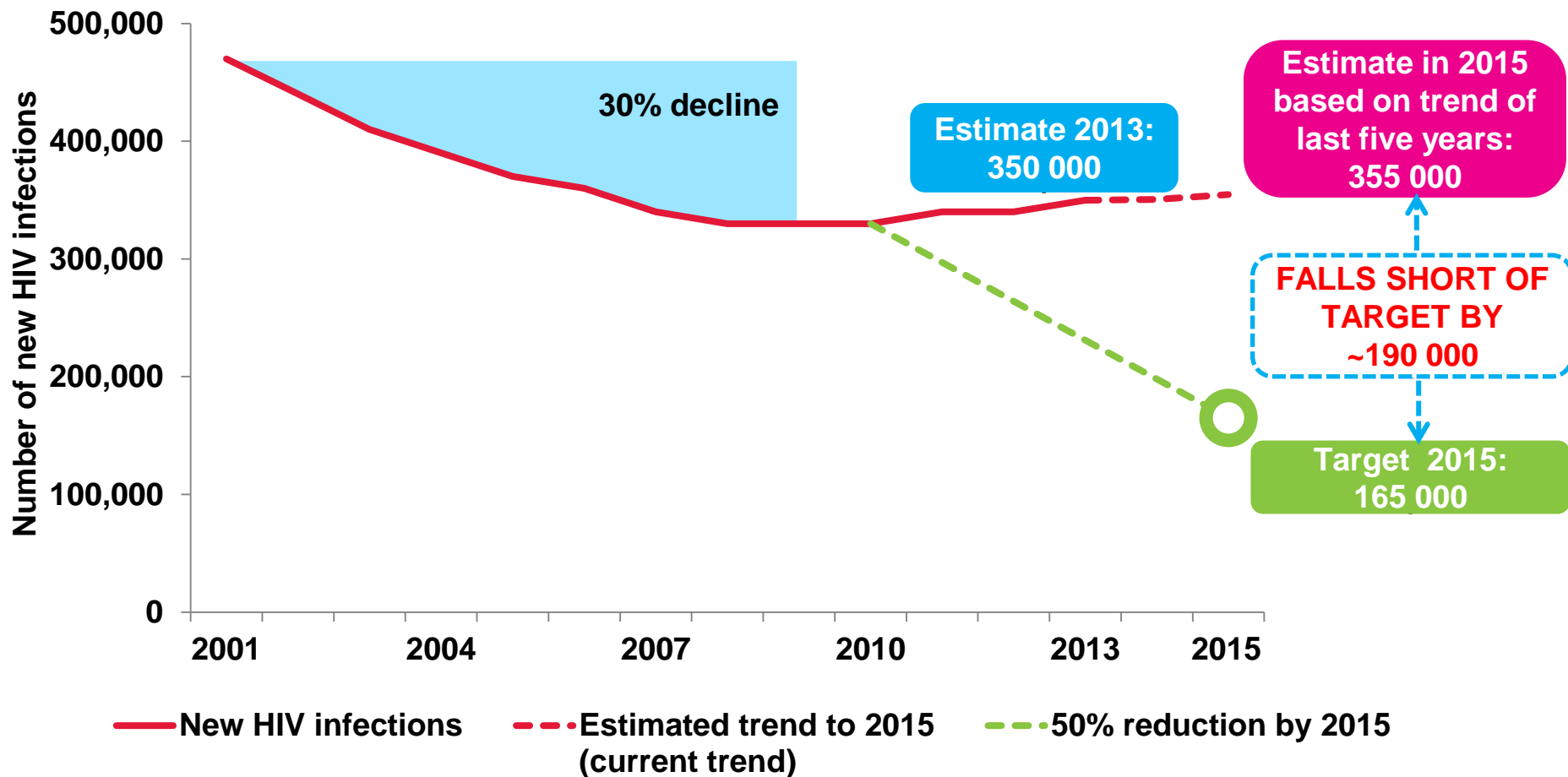


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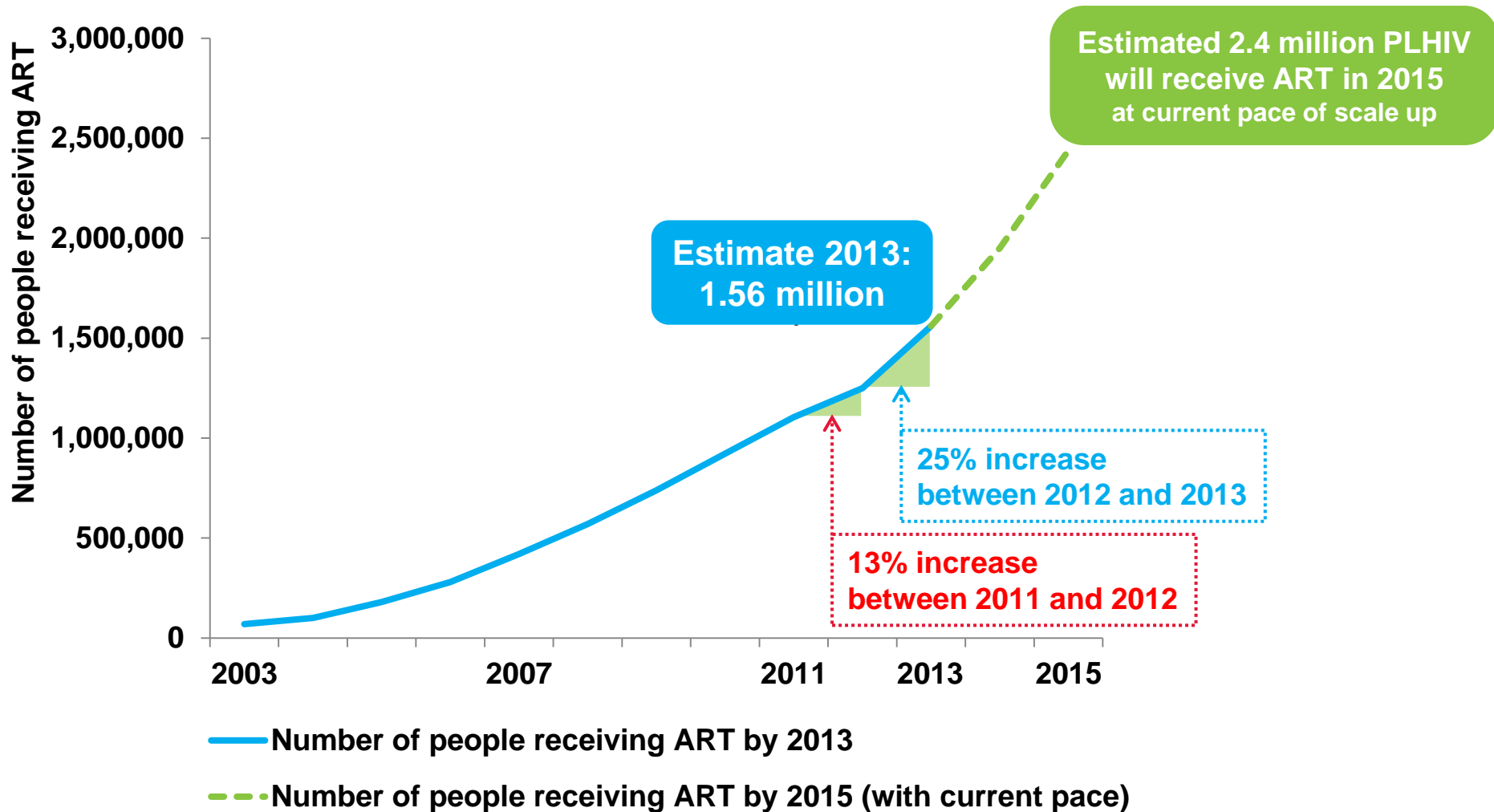
ENDING AIDS BY 2030

REACHING 90 – 90 – 90

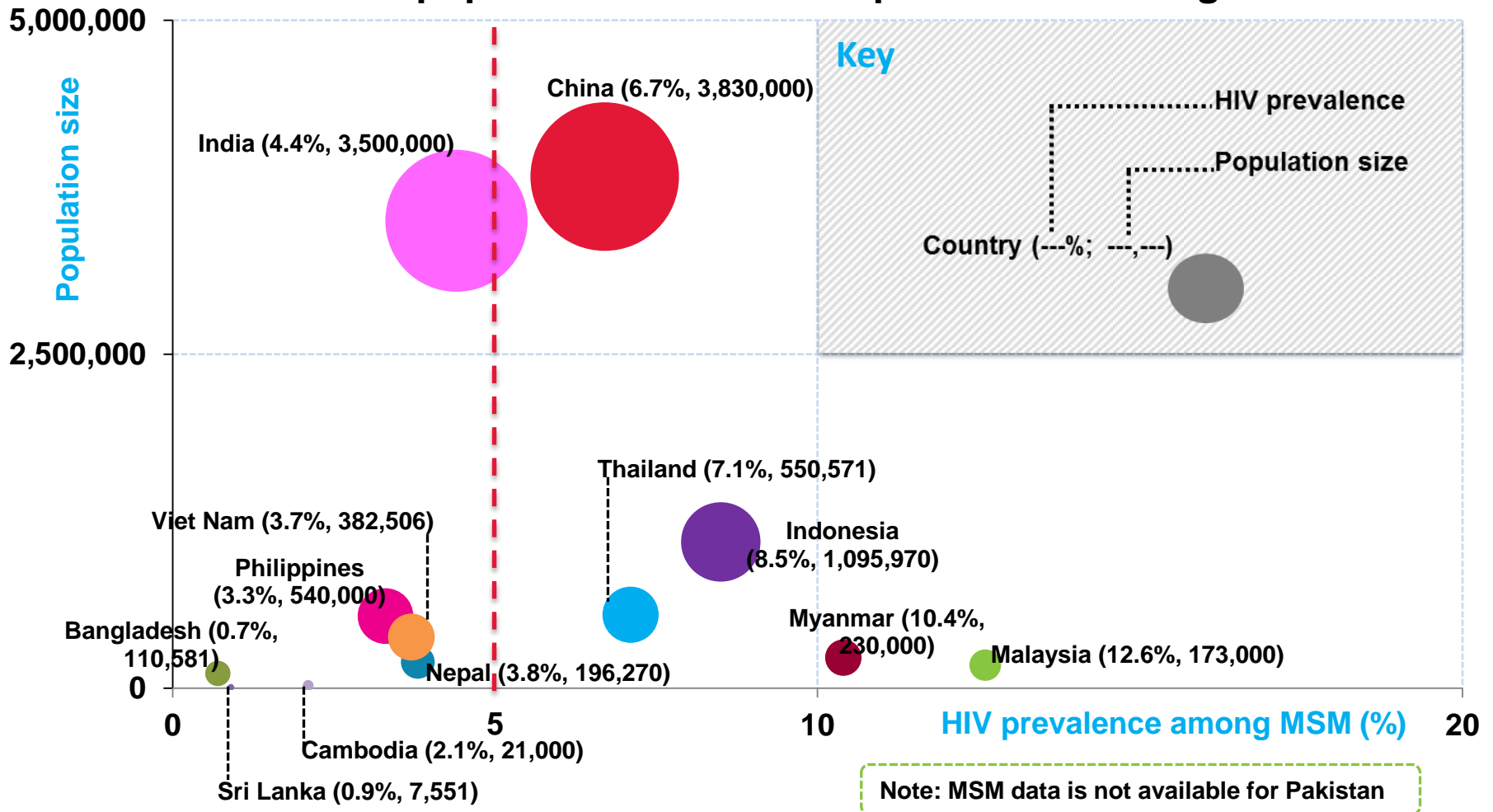
Insufficient scale-up will leave half the people living with HIV without access to treatment by 2015



Focus on the right populations

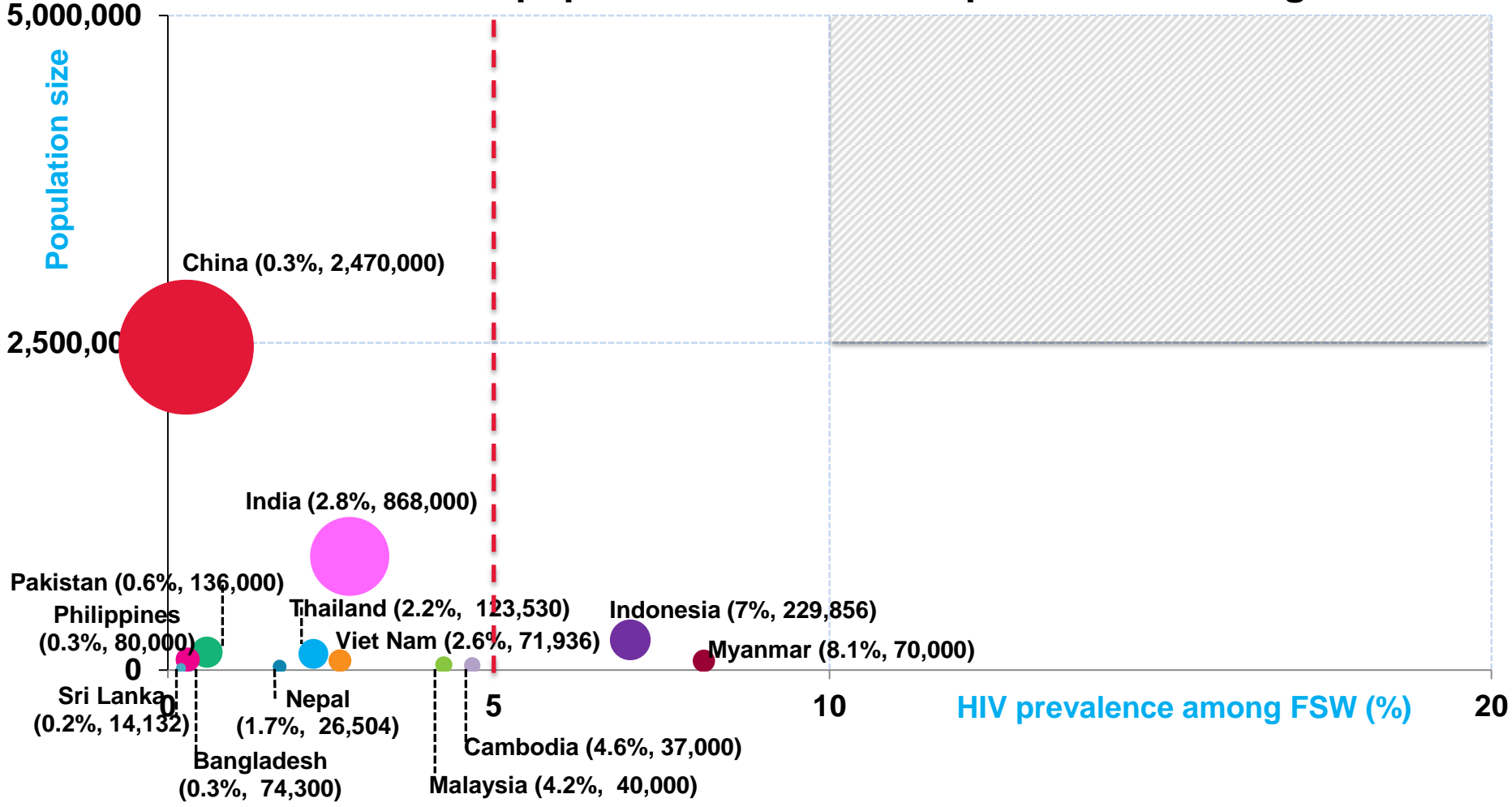
Men who have sex with men are the largest key population at higher risk, with rising HIV prevalence

Women who sell sex are at risk of HIV infection; male clients remain uncounted, with no interventions
